THE ROLE

Execute the guidelines given by the H&S Management and Superintendence regarding the administration of the HS Management System of the company to guarantee its functionality, availability and coherence with the corporate objectives.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- To maintain all the documentation of the H&S Management System organized and updated in conformity with the technical-legal regulations and the internal requirements of the company, under the direction of the H&S Superintendence and in coordination with the H&S General Supervisors / Senior Coordinators of the mine, surface, medical and emergencies areas.
- Carry out the traceability of the changes made in the H&S Management System.
- Communicate internally the changes made in any of the components of the H&S Management System and follow up for their external communication to the operational and support areas.
- Organize and update the labor accident database to ensure immediate access to information when required.
- Organize and update the databases of daily, managerial, and special inspections.
- Follow up on the management of evidence of closure of inspection and incident action plans with the H&S Coordinators assigned to each area, according to the established deadlines.
- Manage the software of the H&S Department, assign roles and train users in each operational and support area. Keep the data bases updated.
- To prepare the daily, weekly, monthly, quarterly, half-yearly and annual reports required by the H&S Management and Superintendence.
- Manage the inventory of the goods and assets that correspond to the H&S Department. Guard equipment, material and supplies.
- Calibrate specialized teams for hygienic and safety measurements.
- Carry out the purchase management of supplies, equipment, materials or other items required for the operation of the H&S Department in coordination with the heads in charge.
