THE ROLE

Lead the group of mechanical maintenance workers with the objective of providing operational capacity for production by executing controls and maintenance work in a safe manner and improving practices and compliance with the maintenance plan.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Execute, with the assigned equipment, the field tasks specific to their area, in all types of weather conditions, while assisting their superiors in the control and coordination of activities.
- Distribute and supervise the work of the personnel under his charge.
- Establish work schedules to be met.
- Give orders and instruct the work group on how to perform assigned tasks.
- Close work order in the ERP system, verifying the correct filling of events associated with equipment.
- Inspect the progress, quality and quantity of work performed.
- Inspects buildings and their surroundings for cleanliness and general maintenance.
- Inspects the good condition of the tools and verify compliance with assigned colors per month, discarding "self-made" tools.
- Estimates the time and materials required for the execution of minor works assigned to his work group and keeps track of them.
- Keeps record of time and materials used in the works.
- Prepares detailed reports of the work performed, materials used, problems encountered and submits them to his/her immediate superior.
