THE ROLE

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Direct and execute the general and specific activities of preparation and adequacy of soils for reforestation purposes.
- Conduct and execute soil sampling at all sites subject to rehabilitation.
- Evaluate the results of soil preparation and suitability.
- Lead and carry out soil conservation action plans in the intervened sites.
- Establish a synchronized work with the coordinator of the biotic component.
- Conduct preventive inspections for loss of geoforms and runoff in reforested sites.
- Execute procurement protocols for the biotic component.
- Organize and direct the crew of workers with the activities in their charge.
