In the fourth quarter of 2019, Lundin Gold realized first gold production as well as the first export of gold concentrate and doré bars. In the first quarter of 2020 FDN achieved commercial production. Lundin Gold operates transparently in accordance with international best practices and according to its three core principles: Working Safely, Environmental Stewardship and Respect.

THE ROLE

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Advise and provide technical assistance to the Social Responsibility and Community Coordinators in the development, management and monitoring of community investment projects.
- Evaluate or reformulate, as appropriate, proposals, projects, plans and programs submitted by local stakeholders to be financed by Lundin Gold.
- Follow up on social investment projects in coordination with the person in charge designated by Lundin Gold - CSR in the area of intervention.
- Establish a monitoring and evaluation framework for the social investment projects implemented by Lundin Gold that includes management and impact indicators that allow us to know the results of each project.
- Issue technical opinions related to pre-investment studies, as well as supervise, monitor and participate in the follow-up of the execution of investment projects.
- Support the planning processes, design and implementation of strategies of the Social Responsibility and Communities department.
- Coordinate the preparation of reports that Lundin Gold delivers to ministries, auditors, etc. on an ongoing basis.
- Review and supervise the preparation of reports submitted to Lundin Gold by external partners on project implementation.
- Coordinate the preparation, implementation and follow-up reports on the results of the different programs developed with key partners of the company (NGOs, academia, companies, etc.).
