### ABOUT US

### THE ROLE

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Provide advice in the field execution of the guidelines contained in the standards, safety procedures, standard operating procedures (SOP) developed for the activities in their area of responsibility, use of HS tools, good practices in Occupational Health and Industrial Safety.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

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- Actively participate in pre-work talks (Morning charlas) conducted by staff in their area of responsibility. Manage the assignment of VLP leaders and encourage the fulfillment of their role inside the work teams.
- Monitor and ensure compliance with guidelines related to the company's VLP Safety Leadership Program.
- Participate together with the area managers in the daily planning of the work and ensure that the HS guidelines are considered in a timely manner.
- Permanently verify in the field that the personnel (supervisor and workers) perform adequate risk management and strictly implement the controls foreseen in the HS tools.
- Provide accompaniment during inspections, audits, visits of government entities and other visits in their area of responsibility.
- Perform formal safety inspections according to the established schedule.
- Participate as a member of the incident investigation team.
- Encourage personnel assigned to their area of responsibility to prepare VLP ARO cards to report unsafe acts and unsafe conditions in their work area.
- Together with the assigned area manager, follow up on the closure of observations raised in inspections and preventive and corrective measures contained in incident action plans.

### SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

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- University Degree in Industrial Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Industrial Safety, Mining, Geology or similar.
- At least 3 years of experience in mining or 5 years in high risk industries.
- Knowledge of incident investigation methodologies and techniques.
