THE ROLE

The Mine Maintenance General Foreman Planning & SAP oversees maintenance program of Mine and Surface fleets. Responsibility also includes the planning and execution of maintenance for all the mobile heavy equipment including heavy construction equipment, gensets, light vehicles and mine and auxiliary electrical installations. Leads the implementation and optimization of the CMMS program through internal and external collaboration.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Monitor the Maintenance Program to ensure commensurate with industry best practices.
- Ensures Preventative Maintenance compliance is in accordance with manufacturer's/industry standards. Reports as to compliance and provides analysis of any variances.
- Reviews maintenance program to ensure plan includes reasonable resources, training, and supervision of a team of skilled and non-skilled workers.
- Ensures maintenance program conforms with manufacturers recommended maintenance and addresses schedules, preventive maintenance equipment repairs, and inspections.
- Assure the complete management of the process workflow, work orders, opening and closing, backlog control, historical documents and archives.
- Supervise the monthly and weekly planning for preventive and corrective works.
- Review and maintain the list of inventory materials required to ensure the availability of such materials for all maintenance activities.
- Oversee the preparation of equipment and materials lists for major jobs to ensure that equipment and materials are available when required.
- Provides recommendations regarding review of contractor's maintenance resources.
- Take leadership of the maintenance budget with the assistance of the managers of different areas. Assure the preparation of the annual departmental OPEX and CAPEX budget is accurate and create control measures to ensure monthly compliance to it.
- Collaborate with operations and engineering regarding planning for LOM equipment.
- Assure the development of the CMMS system SAP. Identify the opportunities of improvement of applications and the performance indicators (KPI) for the maintenance and operations areas.
- Train and coach personnel of the maintenance group to develop the competence of the team.
- Establish good relationships with the operations, engineering, services and supply chain departments.
- Manage the fuel bay area in term of operation and maintenance. Assure the inventory control of diesel and gasoline.
- Provides safety oversight in execution of Underground and Surface Maintenance Program.
- The duties and responsibilities listed above are representative of the nature and level of work assigned and are not necessarily all-inclusive.
