THE ROLE

Be responsible for directing underground development operations during their respective shift. Manage mining teams in charge of ramp and stope development in a manner that encourages individual responsibility.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Manage mine operations to ensure that mine development plans are met (metre advance meters and control of gallery section and quality advances) for the proper development and preparation of the mine, in a safe and efficient manner.
- To be in charge of the development of the mine carried out by own personnel and to offer guidelines, to ensure safe and efficient progress.
- Manage the safety focus and accountability of the staff in charge, promoting teamwork and offering instructions to achieve the goal of safe work and zero incidents.
- Manage resources and minimize waste generation to meet the mine's operating budget.
- Ensure that development areas are kept clean and organized, following design criteria, and controls for compliance with progress on each front.
- Contribute to the planning and scheduling of mining operations to achieve daily, weekly, monthly and annual targets.
- Work with support areas, technical services, maintenance, safety, environment, etc., to achieve the objectives of the plan.
- Participate in the management of underground emergencies to support the efficient resolution of such situations.
- Resolve labor relations issues promptly and fairly, in conjunction with Human Resources.
- Lead and develop subordinates to add value to the company and ensure that mining personnel have adequate training.
