Oversee the core yard facility and material delivered to the ROM stockpiles to make sure all material is stockpiled correctly to ensure the optimal blend for the Mill.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coordinate activities/tasks/projects of the mine geology team including, but not limited to:
- All drilling activities (including contractor supervision).
- Daily grade control activities of mine production (development and stoping).
- Stockpiling of material (High grade, low grade and waste) on the surface.
- QAQC for all sampling and daily tasks.
- Database administration.
- Weekly and monthly reporting communications.
- Monthly reconciliation reporting.
- Track variance Grade control to Forecast and make sure all anomalies are investigated and closed out in a timely manner.
- Development of all Mine Geology function procedures.
- Budget monitoring.
- Core yard activities
- Maintain good communication between all departments to allow for no delays in mine schedules.
- Coach geology personnel and contractor supervisors in all geological and company processes.
- Mentor geology team to create a best practice geology department.
- Improve or maintain best practice within all geological functions.
- Other various project work or duties as required.
