ABOUT US

Fruta del Norte (FDN) is one of the largest and highest-grade gold deposits in the world which is now in production. The Company has an experienced team in mine operations dedicated to advancing FDN responsibly. In the fourth quarter of 2019, Lundin Gold produced the first gold and sent its first tones of concentrate and dore bars. In the first quarter of 2020, FDN reached the commercial production. The Company operates with transparency in accordance with international best practices and its fundamental principles: Working Safely, Environmental Stewardship and Respect.

THE ROLE

The Health and Safety Superintendent is responsible for managing, training and maintaining all safety functions of the FDN project. The Superintendent develops and implements all occupational health and safety programs that comply with all applicable Company rules and regulations and the Health, Safety and Recovery Code. This consists of safety awareness and training programs (at management and departmental levels) for employees, supervisors and contractors. The Health and Safety Superintendent acts as an advisor to all levels of management on safety policies and standards.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist all levels of supervision in preventing accidents by regularly inspecting workplaces and informing supervisors of unsafe practices and conditions and potential hazards.
- Establish precise and effective procedures for the investigation of accidents and complaints by following up all relevant information quickly and thoroughly.
- Ensure compliance with all contractual requirements with respect to safety and inspection of work areas.
- Ensure that all industrial hygiene monitoring is carried out diligently and reported properly.
- Conduct appropriate training programs on loss control, such as safety, first aid, mine rescue, firefighting, emergency response procedures and procedures for handling hazardous products, etc.; and promote applicable awareness programs.
- Carry out the respective emergency procedures in case of a serious incident.
- Provide written reports on safety issues, safety performance, risk management and related aspects in a format consistent with mining industry standards and acceptable to individual inspectors and insurers.
- Keep up to date with relevant safety policies, procedures and regulations through industry contacts, conferences, roundtables and associations, assessing the management of these processes and the potential application and impact on the company's construction activities.
- Ensure that security procedures within each department are generated in a timely manner.
- Train the workforce to meet Lundin Gold standards and train all departments on standard mining procedures for construction and operation.
